



"GOAL FOR EUROPE. YOUTH AT WORK"

Salerno / Capaccio Paestum, November 29 - December 2, 2019 - INFOPACK

The project took inspiration from the Study Visit held in Bruxelles last June, "Democracy Reloaded", organized by the Belgium French-Speaking National Agency (BIJ) in cooperation with other Erasmus+ Youth national agencies. "Democracy Reloaded" was mind-opening regarding the existing cooperation between the local authorities and the Youth sector, and how young people can benefit from an enhanced cooperation.

Youth policy creation event in Italy (NOVEMBER 2019): Creation of European youth policy experimentations, led by high-level public authorities and involving field trials on policy measures in several countries, based on sound evaluation methods: the event in Italy will foresee the participation of strategic members of institution from all the partners, young people and CSOs to create together real effective policies, and to test them during the event in specific sessions. The event is meant to act like a "stress test" for the new policies and cooperation methods created, in order to have them as output and make them available to the institutions from the next day.

Group composition:

8 participants for each country, age range preferably 18-25, Youth Workers, Decision Makers (with no age range). We kindly ask you to provide with a group with people that have experience in the field and topics

Logistics:

To come to Salerno you have two options:

1. Fly to NAPOLI (NAPLES), that is 1 hour from Salerno. Once you get to Napoli Capodichino Airport (NAP), you can take the ALIBUS (bus to Napoli/Naples train station) and from there any train that goes to Salerno. You can take also high-speed trains (ITALO and TRENITALIA FRECCIE), but they take the same time, so I suggest you board on any regional train (<https://www.trenitalia.com/en.html>), select FRECCIE for High-speed train more expensive or REGIONAL for regular trains, while I suggest you buy the regional train tickets directly in the station

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at the automatic ticket counter, in case you could be late and miss the train you book. If you buy the high speed tickets and you miss it, it will not be refunded)

2. Fly to ROME. From either airport (Rome Ciampino CIA or Rome Fiumicino FCO) you can take a train or bus to Roma Termini (train station) and from there we suggest you book a high speed train that takes 2 hours to get to Salerno (<https://www.trenitalia.com/en.html> select FRECCE for High speed train or <https://www.italotreno.it/en> that has only high speed trains).

We suggest you to tell us the flights you are going to book and we will provide help with the rest of the trip.

Meeting point is Salerno, as you probably you will come here by train, and you should be here maximum at 15:00 on November 29. You have plenty of time starting from your country, so please try not to be late.

Plenary

The presentation of the project will take place in plenary in the presence of institutions and the press, in order to convey a message of youth protagonism that is not only of a consultative type, but decision-making. The young people are preparing to carry out days of intense work, based on dialogue and mutual understanding, in order to shape their own future, and in this regard the first day is dedicated to the knowledge and the state of the works even after the first event of Brussels. In this regard, the first part of the presentation will be dedicated to showing the results of the first event, that is the starting points that on the basis of what was seen in Brussels, is considered to be the agenda for youth leadership

Team building

Activity of knowledge and construction of group dynamics: the participants will be divided into groups therefore the management of the group will be entrusted to the project team so that no one feels isolated and / or not very productive

Ideas, proposals, actions: young people at work

Future Search: through an analysis of the various national situations, the participants at the various working groups will have the possibility of proposing possible future solutions to be proposed to political decision makers at all levels; after having worked in subgroups, and having worked out proposals. This activity is central to the project as the young, after having carried out a process of analysis of strengths and weaknesses, and shared good practices, will be "creators of their own destiny" since they are called to create what they desire, or they can lay the foundations for personal development and career development. The task of the facilitators will therefore be to select the different starting points and the areas of greatest interest, and coordinate these works so that a winning and effective strategy for the implementation of youth policies is created

Finalization of the proposals and realization in powerpoint of the ideas arising from the discussions

Definition and elaboration of the resulting proposals, which with the help of the facilitators will be selected and coordinated (to avoid repetitions and overlaps). The groups will therefore be asked to elaborate the presentation that will go into the plenary at the PC, and that will be the first project output.

Participatory budgeting: focus on financial management

Thanks to the ideas of CitizenLab during the Study Visit, the project will have a particular focus on Participatory Budgeting, that is the tool for participation in decisions regarding the financial allocation regarding the territorial policies. The activity will first be explained to the plenary, and then treated in an immersive simulation activity, with the real challenge of economic management of youth policies.

Participatory budgeting: Simulation activities

after the theory the participants will be divided into groups and behind the written instructions of the facilitators they will simulate the management of variable figures for youth policies, for example € 10,000 or € 300,000 depending on the size of the territory and the duration of the intervention. The simulation process involves the division into social and political groups, and discussions leading to the real management of these allocations. The goal is to make known, especially to young less experienced, but also to policy makers who deal with youth policies in a "secondary" way, what are the challenges for both parties but above all what can be the good results drawn from a correct fund management
