Throughout the ESC you will have a **TUTOR** - the wonderful, **kindhearted Margherita**, who will work with you often and will be responsible for the implementation of the activities.





TUTOR

This figure varies depending on the type of project the volunteers are involved in, and it is the person or people who follow and **support the volunteers' daily work**. The tutor trains, explains, and guides the volunteers in their daily activities. They are **the person to whom practical support** can be requested, such as asking for vacation days, permissions, etc.

MENTOR

An important figure in the program, who provides **emotional**, **social**, **and relational support** for the volunteers by organizing both individual and group meetings and activities to assist in each volunteer's growth journey. She help and offer advice on how to overcome challenges and difficulties with their mentors and in their activities.



ACTIVITIES

During the project volunteers will engage in a variety of ways and activities:

MARKET COLLECTION

Contrast food waste by **collecting unsold goods/food at the street markets or bakeries**. It is intended to be a helpful project for families in need, without being a charity service. You as a volunteer will help collecting and together we share everything with people from the community with fewer opportunities.



COOKING LABS

The fantastic **FOOD team** is in charge of these cooking workshops for people in complicated situations in diverse locations in Torino. Besides learning new italian (and non-italian) delicious recipies you'll be fighting food waste.



ENGLISH MEET-UP

In 2018 our EVS volunteers started Language Club where participants can enjoy one hour and a half of speaking in a different language. Both in SpAzi Reali and in Comala, we use non formal methodology, games or discussions to create an easy join atmosphere.



COMMUNITY EVENTS

We are constantly organizing **different events** related to food, social issues or to our own projects. These events are happening **in many locations around the city**, sometimes in collaboration with local or international partners. There is always great food, prepared by the FOOD Team.



ERASMUS+ PROJECTS

A big part of Eufemia is the international Youth Work founded by European Union. There are several groups of Youth Exchanges and Trainings coordinated by our team, and you'll be able to support them!



SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

You can participate in activities where we bring "non formal" to formal: from the preparation of activities to actually being in an italian class! We work in a school in Barriera di Milano during the whole year and travel around the region to bring our workshops to other schools.



OFFICE

Our office is located in **C.so Francesco Ferrucci,67**. It's located in the former **Caserma La Marmora**, a structure from the secondhalf of the 19th century that has been recovered and now is hosting Eufemiaand also other cultural organizations like **Comala, Border Radio, TILT, PERCStudio and Cit Turin**. Since it is a public space and lots of things happen in there every week, it'salways full of people, mostly students, joining the activities or having coffee(but Spritz is more popular).



ACCOMODATION

CORSO MONTE NERO, 12

The **Monte Nero apartment** is a shared house, which means that you share all the common areas and each room will be shared by two volunteers.

The location is convenient: **2 minutes from a tram/bus** stop, bike share station, various supermarkets, open market, bars and restaurants. It's easy to get to the city centre - by tram you're there within **15 minutes**.

The apartment has three bedrooms, two bathrooms, a living room, a large kitchen, a long hall, four balconies and a yard where we can safely store our bikes! In addition, the apartment is equipped with all necessary appliances such as fridge, freezer, oven, electric kettle, washing machine, vacuum cleaner, etc.

Plus we have a projector so we can watch movies together and feel like in a cinema :)

STEPS IN TURIN

In the first months of your ESC project, a significant attention will be put on your inclusion. Therefore, Italian language lessons will be provided for you and you will attend in back office activities. Later on, you will be more engaged in the regular activities to become **more confident and autonomous**.

You will also start planning your personal project!

Also, a great attention will be dedicated to the capacity to "walk and work independently". You will be working in a team, so **you'll never be alone, but you will have some responsibilities**, to challenge yourself and learn how to self manage little tasks. Some projects will require you to actively contribute with your ideas and creativity, so don't be shy and don't be afraid to give a fresh and critical look on what you see!

HOLIDAYS AND WORKING HOURS

Volunteers week is usually **from Monday to Friday or Tuesday to Saturday** depending on your activities, with a **range from 30 to 38 work weekly hours.**

Flexibility isrequested as some events might be on free days, but you'll get them back.

Each week has 2 free days

Every month you can collect 2 free days that you can use as you want.

You can collect them and enjoy all together, **but always** share and discuss your plans with the tutor and coordinator to better organize activities, at least two weeks before.

Normally, the summer period is the common time for holidays such as othernational/bank holidays in the country.

- Torino Caselle Airport: by bus to Porta Susa fare
 7.5€ <u>Sadem</u> bus line
- By **train to Dora GTT** fare 3€ <u>GTT</u>
- Milano Bergamo Airport: by shuttle bus to Vittorio
 Emanuele fare around 15€ *Flixbus*.
- Milano Malpensa Airport: by shuttle bus to Porta Susa - fare 22€ - <u>Arriva</u>

WHAT WILL BE PROVIDED?

- In the house there will be **shared bikes** that you can use for visit the city.
- you will be provided by extra money for a monthly, public transport ticket (25€ for under 25 y.o.) for all the public transports (metro, tram, bus in the metropolitan area).

FOOD AND POCKET MONEY

 6€ per day as food allowance, 6€ per day as pocket money (individual support).

HEALTH INSURANCE

- You will be insured by the **Henner Insurance Plan** and receive their personalmembership card.
- Check: Medical plan, Benefits overview, Insurance card, European health

TAKE IT SERIOUSLY



- Get a museum card If you are under 26, you can get it for 32€/1 year. Over 26 it is 52€. This card will give you access to all the museums in Torino and to some in region of Piedmont.
- Don't waste your free time on buses. WALK OR TAKE THE BIKE!
- Bring or buy your own (non plastic) bottle, Torino has a lot of fountains, where you can refill it

TAKE IT EASY

- Do **shopping in January and July**. Sales are insane.
- **KEEP CALM!** Always, no matter what, don't panic.
- Enjoy Italian food but be aware that it will affect your body. Work out!
- **In's** supermarket is one of the cheapest around, Conad is better quality but more expensive, also there is Lidl, Auchan, Ekom, Pam & Carrefour easy reachable by bike.
