


INFO - ORGANIZATION



MONTIS - Associação para a Gestão e Conservação da Natureza, is a Portuguese non-profit organization dedicated to nature conservation. It is based in Vouzela, Viseu, and was created in 2014. The association mission is to create value with biodiversity, through the management of natural heritage, participatory, transparent, and open to all interested parties.

The association's activities focus on active land that it owns management of whose management custody it provides, which currently covers around 300 ha, mostly in the center of the country (Vouzela, Pedro do São Sul. Arouca. Pampilhosa Covilhã). Serra and We manage abandoned marginal land, by supporting or restoring key natural processes, namely contributing to increase the value of biodiversity and fire resilience, involving communities through short term and long term volunteering.

THE TASKS

Volunteers will be involved in different nature conservaiton tasks for ecological restoration of forest areas. The main tasks will include: **support of natural regeneration** by prunning of trees to enhance growth, **natural engineering techniques** to prevent soil erosion and support of waterlines, **plantation** of native species, maintenance of paths and clearings, **control of invasive species** and more.

The volunteers will also be engaging with the **activities planned** by the association for the time they will be with us, such as activities for the community, schools, companies, international work camps, bioblitzs, biodiveristy walks and more.

CONDITIONS



To participate in the project, volunteers must:

- Be between 18 and 30 years old
- · Be physically fit
- Have motivation to participate in a nature conservation project
- Have respect for others and the values of the European Solidarity Corps
- Have willingness to acquire or develop language skills, especially English and Portuguese.

PLACES WHERE ACTIVITIES CAN TAKE PLACE

MONTIS has around 300ha of land under management in Portugal, the volunteer will be working on different areas depending on the time of the volunteering period and ecological needs for each area. The association office is in **Vouzela**. Some areas where we will be working:



Pampilhosa da Serra (Cabril and Souto do Brejo)

- Total area: 11 ha
- Acquired through crowdfunding
- Eucalyptus forest conversion to native forest
- Here, support will be given to natural regeneration, some planting will be done to enhance the habitat, control of invasive species (eucalyptus) and accesses will be opened and maintained

Baldio de Carvalhais (São Pedro do Sul)

- Total area: 100 ha
- Located in wolf territory and part of Natura 2000
 Network Special Areas of Conservation (SAC)
 Serras da Freita e Arada (PTCON0047), in Arada mountains
- Mountain habitat where the forest has been replaced by brooms due to lack of management and absence of forest fires
- Recovery of the area's forest mosaic





Vieiro (São Pedro do Sul)

- Total area: 25 ha
- Burned in 2024
- Abundant natural regeneration of cork oaks and oaks.
- Here, support will be given to control of invasive species, plantations, and support of natural regeneration after the fire.
